2018/180 Co-Option of Councillors	1. The Chairman proposed that Mr Paul Manning be co-opted onto the Parish Council. This was seconded by Mrs McManus. All councillors voted unanimously in favour. 2. Mrs A'Bear proposed that Mr Barry Nichols be co-opted onto the Parish Council. This was seconded by Mrs Heatley. At a vote, Mrs McManus abstained, but all other councillors voted in favour. 3. Mrs Heatley proposed that Mr John Padfield be co-opted onto the Parish Council. This was seconded by Mr Wiltshire. All Councillors voted unanimously in favour. The new Councillors present signed their Declarations of Office.	
2018/181 Local Councillor Matters	1. <u>Budget</u> - Councillor Seed reported that Wiltshire Council's budget proposals for the 2018-19 financial year had been approved. 2. <u>Seend CLT</u> - He reported that he had had a positive meeting with Mr George Clarke, Chairman of the steering group of the Seend CLT and all was progressing well. 3. <u>Blossom Hill</u> - A councillor mentioned that there seemed to be 3 caravans currently on site, the original one and two new. Councillor Seed said that once the construction of the site was completed, there should then just be one static caravan, a day room and one mobile caravan on the site.

2018/183 Minutes of the Previous Meeting	1. The Minutes of the meeting held on 30 th January 2018 had been circulated to all Councillors. 1.1 <u>Resolved:</u> Acceptance of the Minutes as an accurate record was proposed by Mrs Heatley and seconded by Mr Wiltshire. Mr Manning and Mr Padfield did not vote as they had not attended the meeting, All other Councillors present unanimously approved the minutes.	
2018/184 Matters Arising Not Already on the Agenda	1. <u>Spout Lane Bridge Minute 17/134.3</u> - The Clerk reported the C& RT had been made aware of the structural problems and that they had responded saying they would make a site inspection. Mrs A'Bear said that we would need to keep an eye on the bridge and, if no action was taken in the next six months, to contact the C&RT again. 2. <u>Defibrillator Minute 17/171.1</u> - The Clerk confirmed that this had now been installed by the electrician, and that it was now registered on the SW Ambulance Services register and the CHT's WebNos. The Clerk said she had been shown how to do the weekly checks by Mr Wood, and that he had agreed to do a training session in the Brewery.
